#### FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended funeral, the burial fee. 1

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is **£920.00**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. 2

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: **£675.00 - £890.00**

1 This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

2. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
